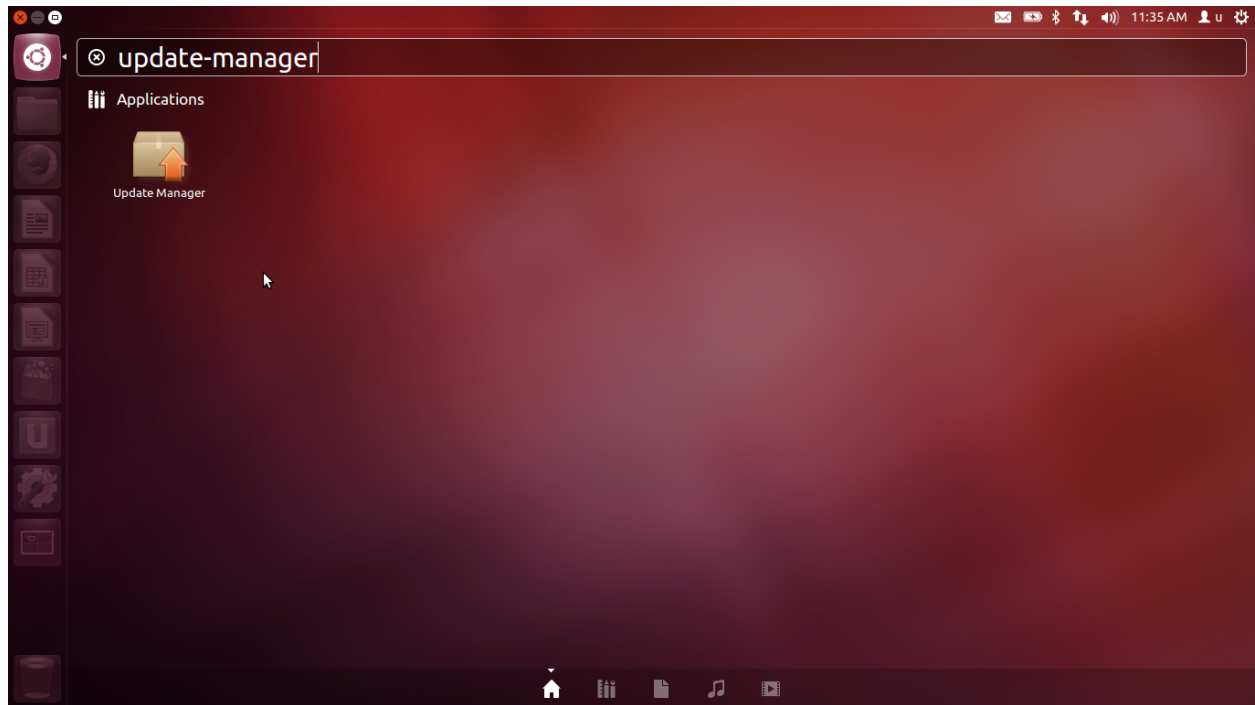
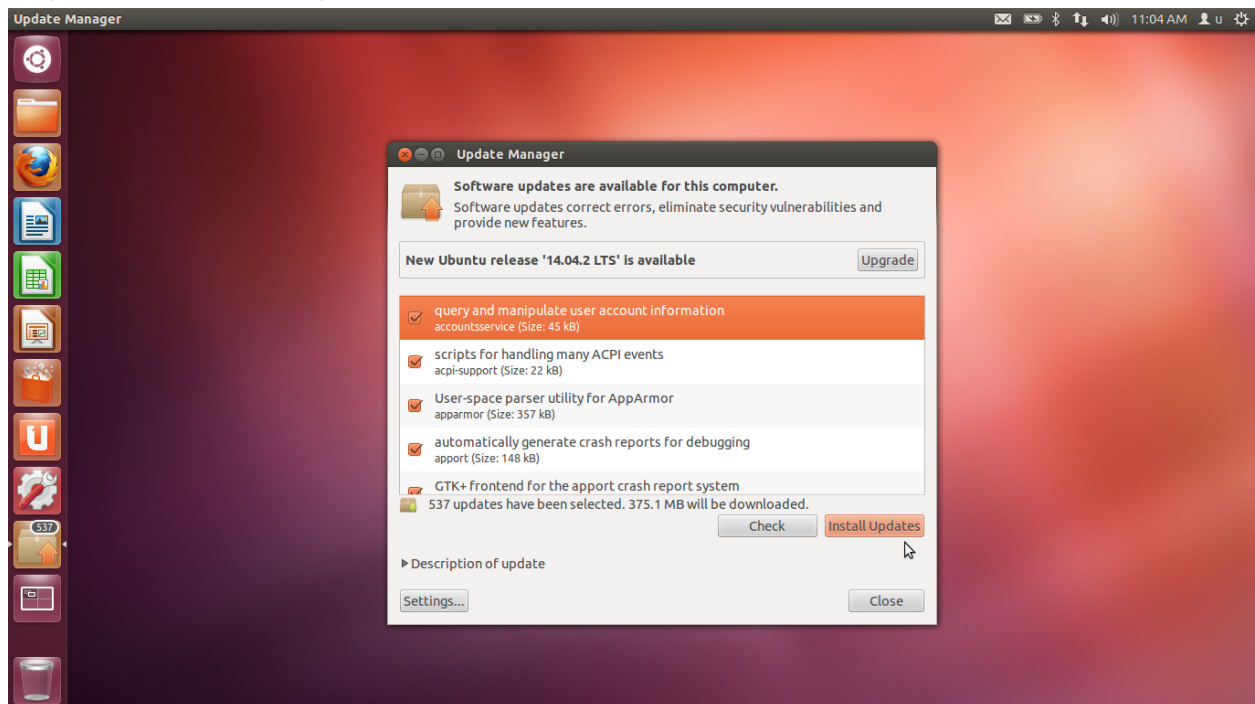


How to Upgrade your system?

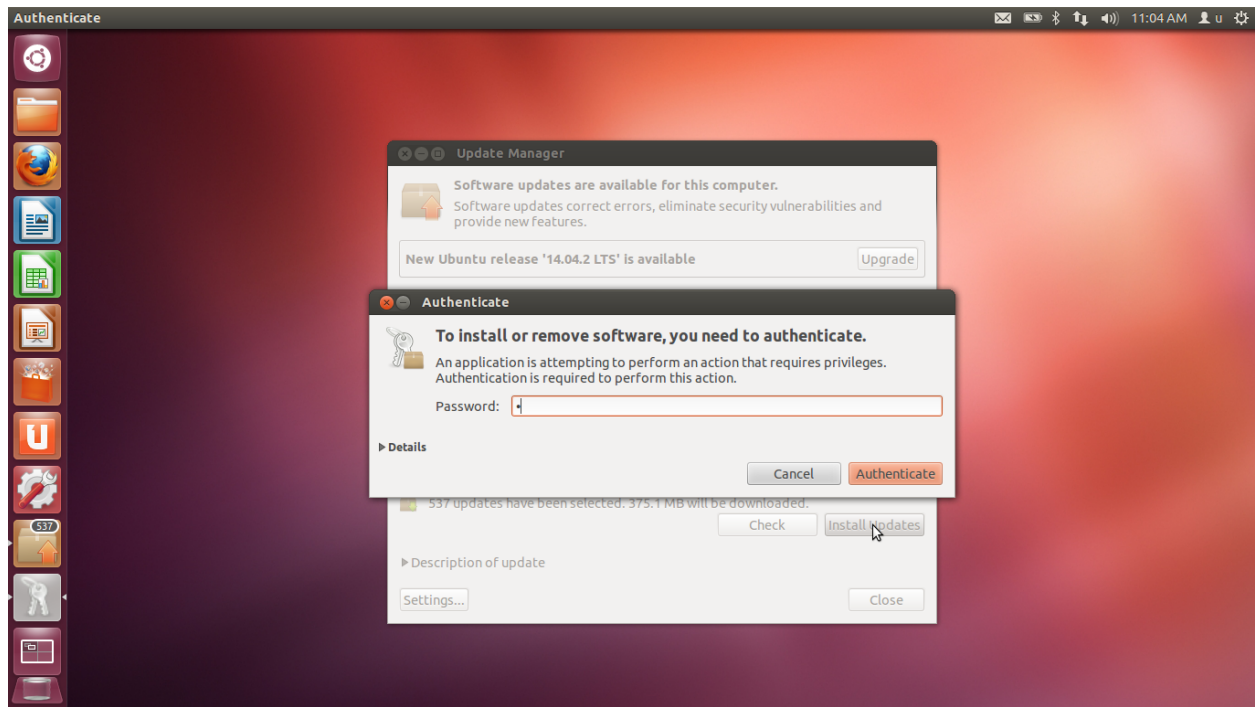
Step 1: Launch update-manager from Dash



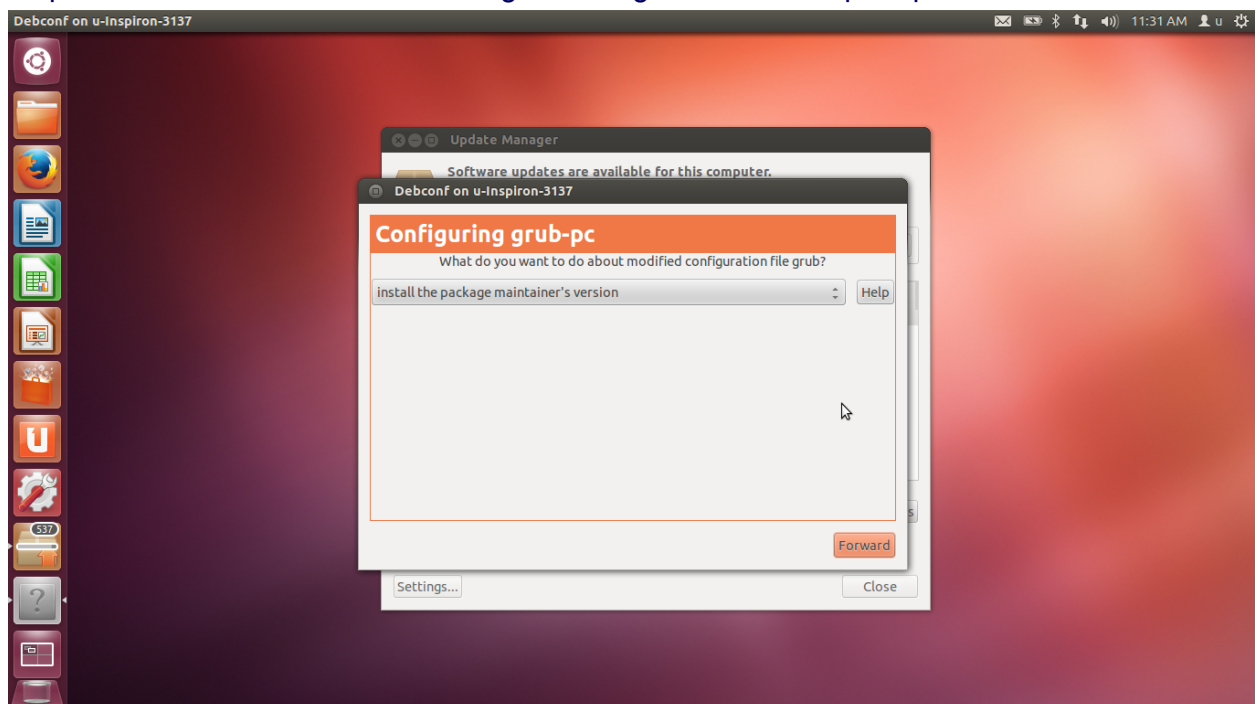
Step 2: Select "Install Updates" button



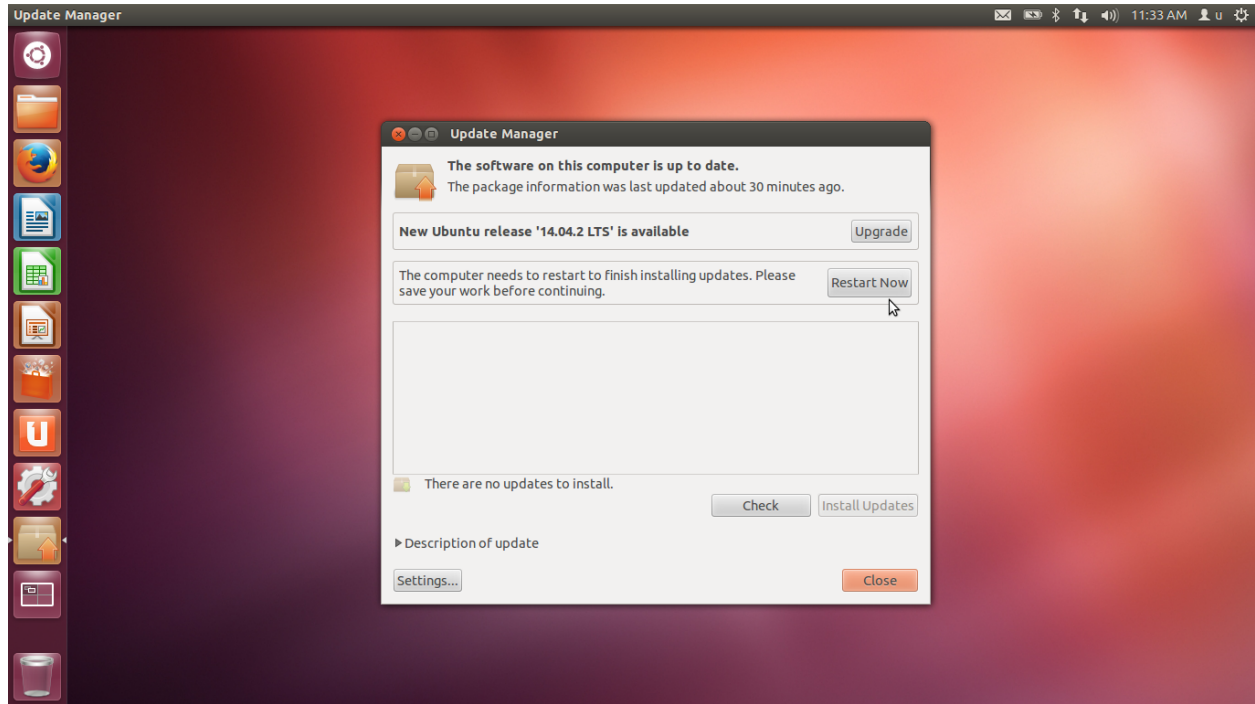
Step 2-1: Insert user password when prompted



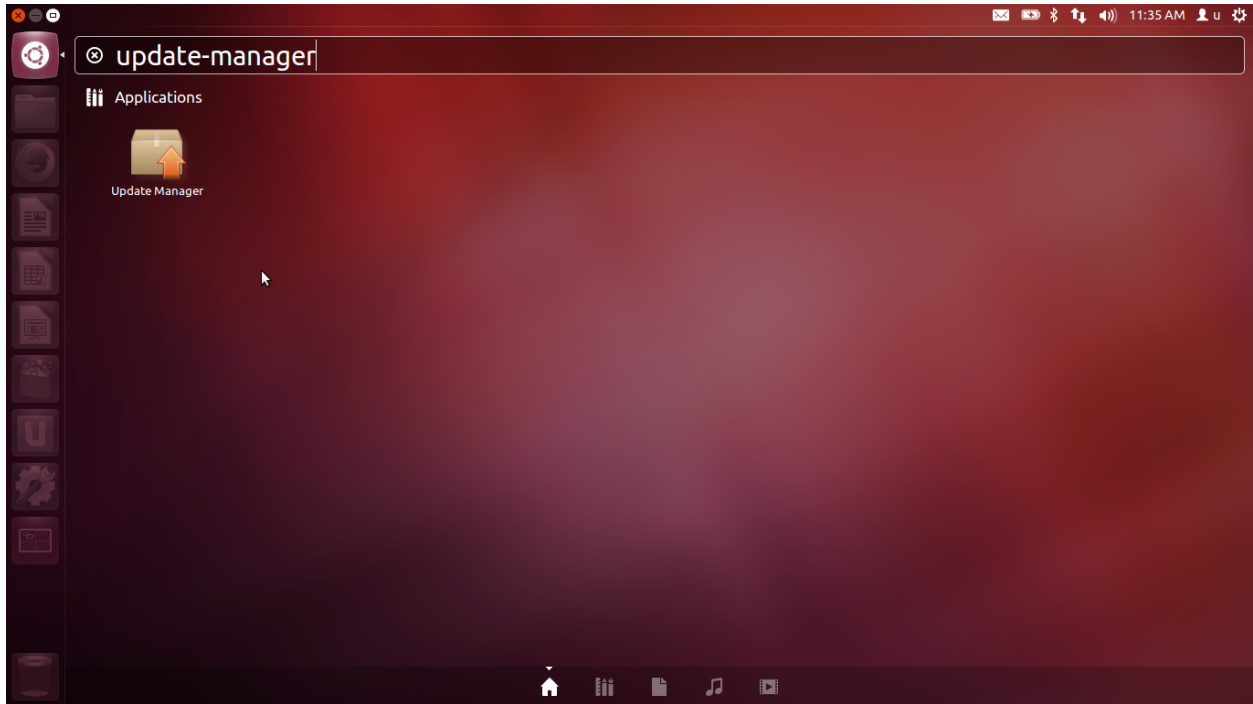
Step 2-2: Recommend to use default grub configurations when prompted



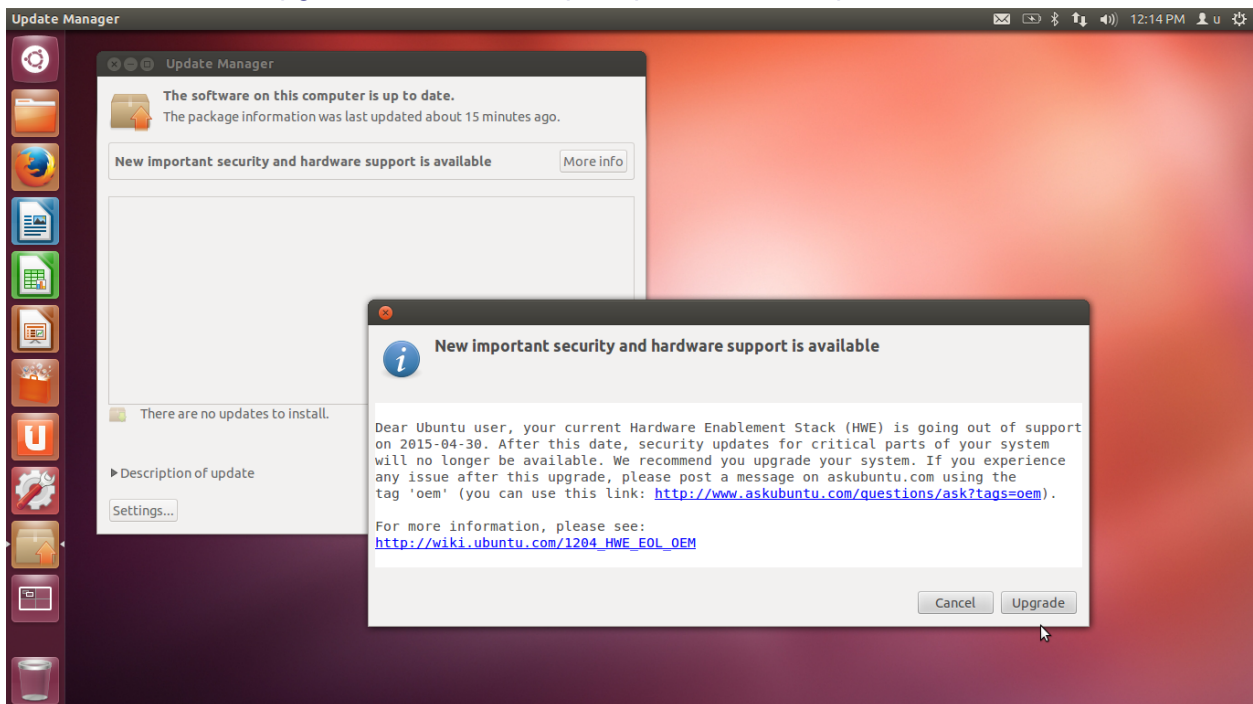
Step 2-3: When installation is complete, system will prompt user to reboot. Reboot as prompted.



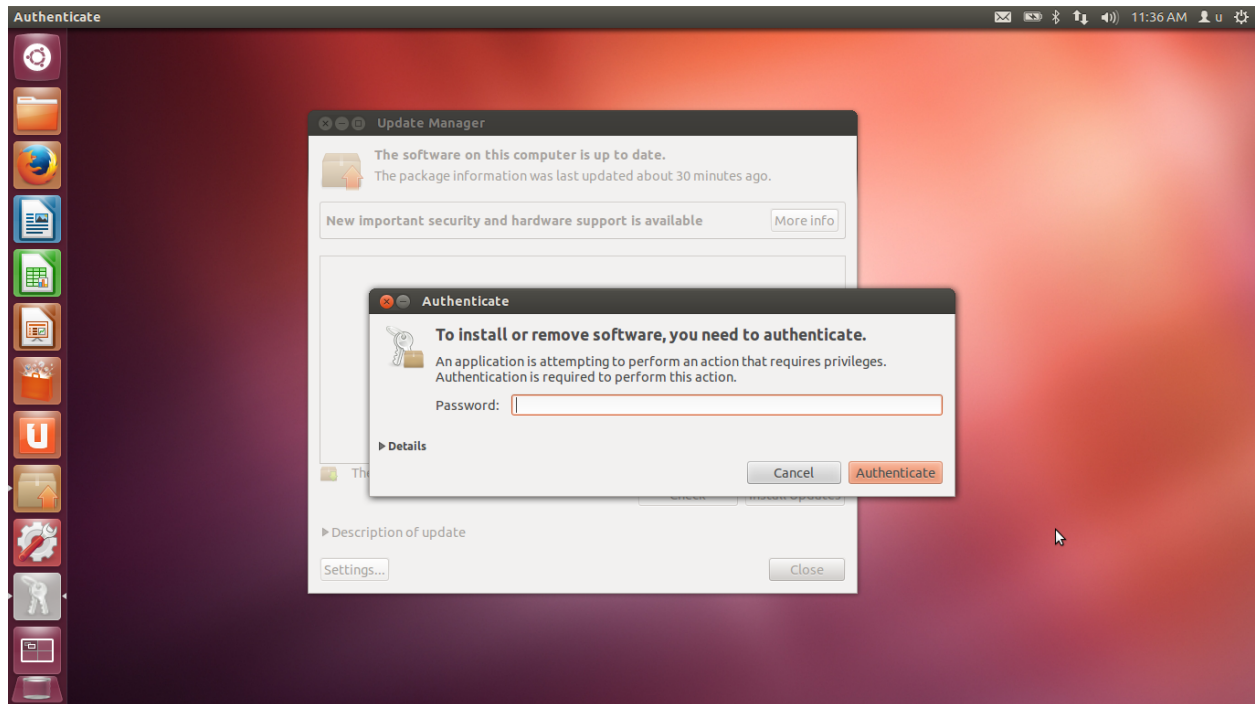
Step 3: Launch update-manager again from Dash after system reboot



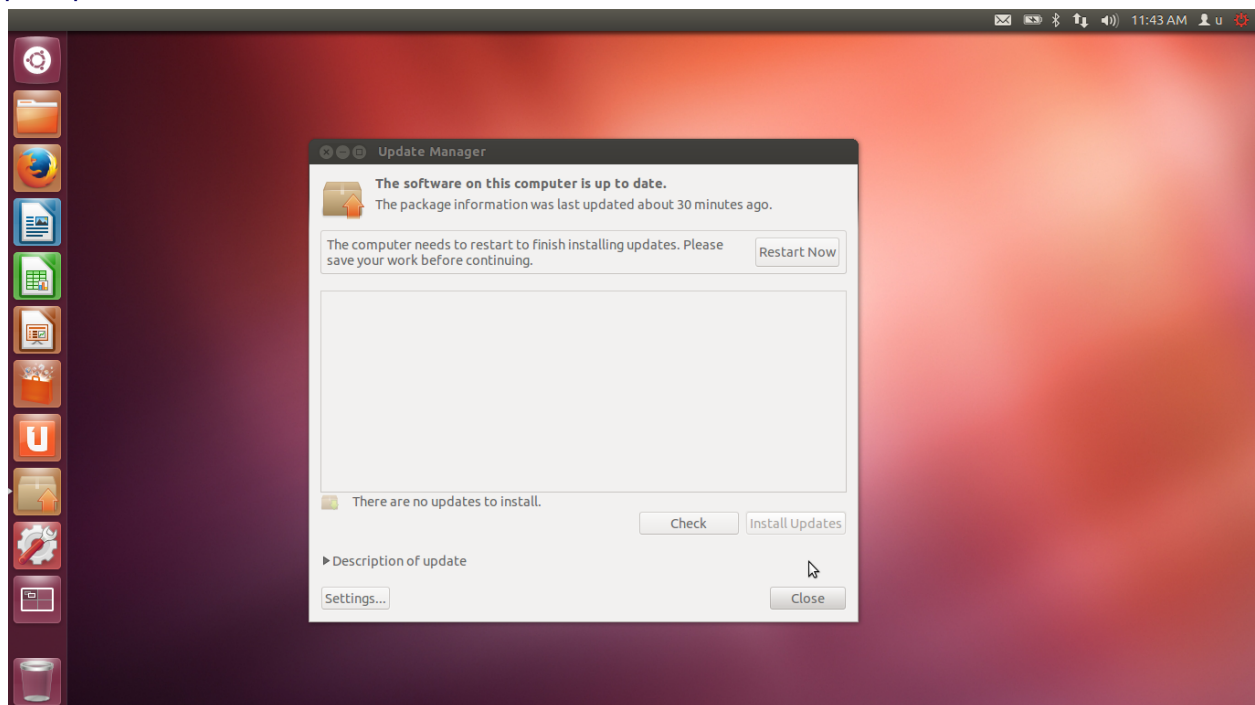
Step 4: Click "More Info" button in "New important security and hardware update is available" section, then click "Upgrade" button in the prompt that shows up.



Step 4-1: Insert user password when prompted.

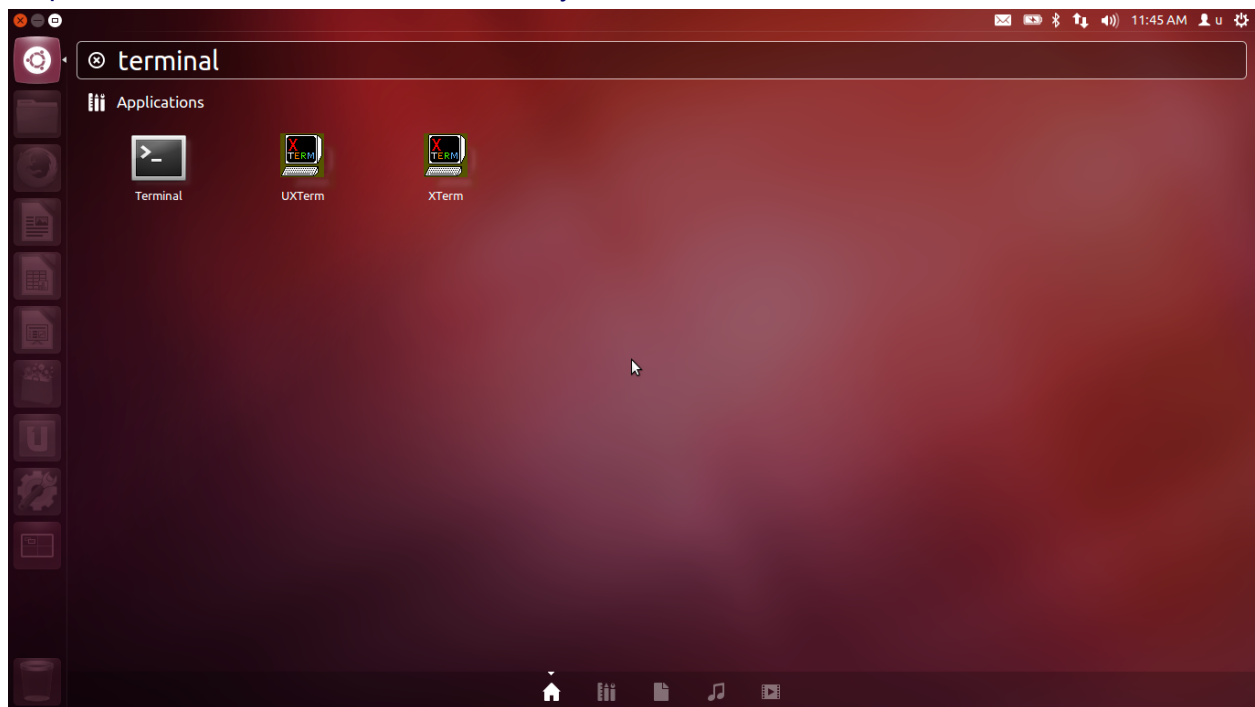


Step 4-2: When installation is complete, system will prompt user to reboot. Reboot as prompted.



Checking if upgrade is successful

Step 5: Launch terminal from Dash after system is rebooted.



Step 6: Use the following commands:

"uname -r" to check kernel version - Output should be "3.13.x-xx-generic"

"lsb_release -a" - Output of "Description" column should be "Ubuntu 12.04.5 LTS".
